

Bibliography and resources: Intro to Norway:

A few samples of books. Other books of similar topics can also be found.

1. Skavhaug, Kjersti. *Våre Vakre Bunader*. (In Norwegian, but with full page photographs of all the bunads of Norway. Hemmes Forlag, 1985. There are also other bunad books published later.
2. *Living in Norway*. Photography by Sølvi Dos Santos, Adapted texts by Elizabeth Holte, preface by Knut Faldbakken. Flammarion, Paris, 1993. Excellent full color photographs from all over Norway. In English.
3. *Norwegian Wood. A Tradition of Building*. By Jerri Holan. Rizzoli International Publications, New York, 1990. Detailed black and white illustrations and photographs and color photographs, showing how wood is “a basic environmental fact”. Shows the amazing different styles of architecture that make traditional buildings in Norway so Norwegian.
4. *Norwegian Folk Tales*. From the collection of Peter Christian Asbjørnsen and Jørgen Moe. Illustrated by Erik Werenskjold and Theodore Kittelsen. Dreyers Forlag, 1960. Those four names represent the best in Norwegian folk tales and illustration. If you cannot find this particular book, at least look for those names in other books.
5. *Norwegian Folk Art. The Migration of a Tradition*. Marion Nelson, editor. Abbeville Press, New York. 1995. In English. From textiles to wood, toys and useful articles, all manner of traditional items common in Norway. Photographs both in color and in black and white. Includes bunads.
